The Carpenter safely performs all carpentry and assigned tasks on job sites. Carpenters are responsible in performing work to the highest quality and safety standards while also assisting less experienced team members. Carpenters will report directly to the Foreman or Superintendent on site.

Responsibilities

Essential Duties

- Maintain personal safety and ensure operations allow for the safety of others
- General carpentry framing with wood and steel studs: ie: walls, stairs, roofs and floors
- Inspection and operation of hand and power tools
- Inspection and operation of aerial equipment, skid steers and forklifts
- Lead, teach, and oversee carpenters and laborers as tasks are being performed
- Ability to lead the crew for short durations in absence of the foreman
- Observing and enforcing utilization of all safety equipment following requirements of Greystone, OSHA and the Client
- Demolition
- Installation of windows, doors and hardware
- Assembly of bathroom partitions and accessories
- Modify and install cabinets and countertops
- Install and tape drywall
- Unload materials, store efficiently and stage jobsite for operations
- Maintain a clean and safe job site
- Perform other related duties as required
