- Required: OSHA 10 and first aid; preferred: OSHA 30.
- Must have direct supervisory skills and experience with managing construction crews. The direct supervisory skills include training, assigning onsite labor, providing safety/OSHA instruction, performing cost control procedures, and maintaining all necessary supporting documentation of the activities.
- Ability to travel to job sites as required.
- Must be able to read and interpret plans, specifications, and shop drawings.
