The Specialty Building Erector safety performs tasks involving the erection of steel framed buildings to meet and exceed industry standards. Erectors assist with building layout, steel erection, fabric tensioning and detailing as well as install foundations on occasion. Specialty Building Erectors report directly to the Foreman on site.

Responsibilities

Essential Duties

- Maintain personal safety and ensure operations allow for the safety of others on the job site
- Perform installations of pre-engineered buildings
- Safely work following steel erection plans, daily preplans and weekly toolbox talks prepared by the foreman
- Assemble and erect steel
- Pull, tension, and detail fabric
- Install steel sheeting and trims
- Frame and terminate openings
- Install doors, and other accessories
- Unload materials and store efficiently onsite
- Maintain a clean safe jobsite
- Keep work areas supplied with materials and clear of construction debris
- Perform other related duties as required
- Ability to operate equipment such as skid steers, personnel lifts, and forklifts

- Knowledge of acceptable construction site practices including occupational safety and health regulations
- Ability to communicate both orally and in writing with internal and external clients and coworkers
- Ability to follow direction is required
- Ability to determine the tools and equipment needed to complete each task effectively
